CITIZEN REQUESTS

- (1) Ladd Road project will be take place 3-0. Gary will help organize. Some residents have offered to donate money to help rent the dumpster, others may volunteer to help.
- (2) Residents on Elm Street would like ditching on far end of Elm Street. Discussion as to other areas that need ditching
- (3) Holes on Beech Hill Road need work ne on Beech Hill Road.

ROADS

- (1) West Sandy River Road project still being researched as to surface options. Rome buys a crushed product from Pike's in Sidney. Prices of different surfaces need to be compared, also quality of the material.
- (2) Main Street bridge – State Fish and Game representative will visit with Selectmen to discuss. Check on possibility of some State funding. On Donnie's list.
- (3) Elm Street culvert project ready to start. Also the beaver issue will be addressed. Dig Safe is now on board. Notice will be posted and emailed about road closure.
- (4) Gary will check on Decker Road status.

TOWN FOREST - There has been no reply from Surveyor Will Boynton regarding Town's request for a boundary line description.

LRAP - Paper work for 2018 LRAP project was signed.

ROUTE 2 TRAFFIC LIGHT - Agreement with State for replacement of the traffic light on Rt. 2 was signed.

WARRANT PREVIEW - approved 3-0. **FINAL WARRANT** signed.

2019 TAX BILLS – Six landowners on North Pond inquired about tax bills.

WINTER ROADS - Part of the salt order has been delivered. Our price is locked in until July 2020.
