Open Meeting: Gerry Redlevske opened it at 6:00 pm

Citizens Inquires:

- Daren Turner – provided a Town Forest Update at this time \$41,038 to date. They had been cutting on the riverside the last 2 weeks, there are a few piles that are all cut and will haul once it is below freezing, there are 6 loads that have been moved over to Gerry's place on Route 2 to get them off the posted roads while frozen. The Loggers should be done by this week and then it will take a few weeks for the checks to come in. The Town should receive just over \$50K after it is complete. Daren will do a report after it is done completely. Daren stated Duncan did a great job and worked well with him. .
- Resident asked if a different moderator could be used for the Town Meeting? Selectmen stated it is too late for this year's meeting to change. The New Board can make a decision for next year.

Old Business:

- Transfer Station Annual Report is due, Gerry will try to come in and complete it this week.

- Culverts ordered from Campbell's are in, will deliver when we are ready for them.
- Letter Received from Dept of Agriculture, Conservation & Forestry was reviewed by the Selectmen.
