Selectmen's Meeting - 02/13/2020

Open Meeting: Vern W. called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm

Citizens Request:

- Ricky Parlin complained that Main Street is showing signs of abuse by the logging trucks and requested that it be posted. Vern made a motion to post Main Street. Gary seconded it. Arrangements for the roads to be posted in the next few days by Vern & Gary.

Old Business:

- Chimney lining and column repair is complete!
- Audit with Mr. hood went well.
- Gary had met with Overhead Doors, we are still waiting on a quote for doors on the salt shed from them.
- Winter Roads: Salt order is up to 266 tons on the extra allowed to be ordered.
- Gary confirmed with Vern that he received the letter about the Removal of his Equipment off the Town property at the Salt Shed by Feb. 27<sup>th</sup>, Vern said he did.

New Business:

- Change on Article 27 Summer Roads, the sum of money will be \$60,000 will come from taxes and \$20,000 will come from Town Forest Revenue. The budget committee approved it 4-1-1, all by email. As the selectmen made the change after the BC met.
- School board minutes were read. Mercer has 86 children enrolled at the cost of about \$6600 per student.
- D.O.T. requested that the bridge on East Sandy River Rd, just before the transfer station, be posted with a 22 ton limit.
- The town received an email from the abutting land owner of the Town wood lot on the river side of Elm Street. The email questioned the decision on the boundary. All deeds have been signed and recorded so any questions will be directed to Boynton & Pickett, who did the deed research.
- Health Officer, Yolanda will reach out to Nicole Ray to see if she will continue to be the Local Health Officer.
- Vern was asked to return the road signs that he has in his garage that belong to the Town by the end of February. He said he has returned all the posts all ready.

- Warrant preview was approved, 2-0, then signed.

- Minutes from 01-23-20 were reviewed but not approved as Vern was not at the 1/23/20 meeting and Gerry is not at this meeting to approve them. Will approve at 2/27/20 meeting.
